Driver Safety Meeting – Burnout Rules:

1. Driver Safety Meeting must be attended immediately preceding the session.
2. You are personally responsible for any and all consequences of your participation.
3. All occupants, including driver, must sign the liability release prior to entering the pit.
4. Wristband must be worn by driver that indicates driver was at the rules meeting.
5. All occupants, including driver, must be at least 18 years of age.
6. Vehicle and driver must be currently legal to operate on public streets. i.e.:
 - a. Current license for both car and driver.
 - b. Current vehicle insurance.
 - c. Sober.
 - d. Etc.
7. Vehicle should be checked to ensure it does not have any loose pieces that may fall off.
8. Do not begin burnout until given the signal from the Pit Boss.
9. Driver will carry a two-way radio in their vehicle while performing burnout and immediately stop burnout if warning alert is sounded.
10. Driver will also watch for orange flags and immediately stop burnout if flag is waved by any Pit Boss.
11. Asphalt must not be damaged. Vehicle must not sit in one spot while spinning tires.
12. Avoid all contact with barriers. Your session will be immediately terminated upon any barrier contact – No matter how slight.
13. Barrier contact will disqualify that run and eliminate medal contention for that driver for the entire event.
14. Failure to follow these rules may disqualify you from future participation in this event.
